- b. Change the following statement "Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin." to: "Never use repellents over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin."
- c. Change the following statement "Avoid over application of this product." to:
 "Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Heavy
 application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness; if biting insects do not
 respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more.
- d. Change the following statements: "After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again." to" After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water or bathe. This is particularly important when repellents are used repeatedly in a day or on consecutive days. Also, wash treated clothing before wearing it again.
- 2. In accordance with PR Notice 2001-6: Change the following statement within the Storage and Disposal Section as follows: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or [toll free number which meets the criteria in paragraph I.I.E.] for disposal instructions.
- 3. To be eligible for reregistration, aerosol and pump spray formulations must be packaged in containers utilizing a concave trigger to help aim product or other comparable mechanism that will ensure that the product will not be inadvertently sprayed in he eyes.
- 4. The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines for repellent products. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-in to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.
- 5. A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records.
