

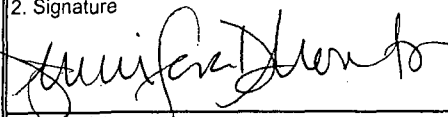

Please find enclosed notification per PR Notice 98-10 to add the following optional marketing claim as requested by the state of New York: **"Contains Picaridin"**.

We understand that Picaridin submissions are being reviewed closely and claims are not to be notified typically. However, we would ask that this be considered acceptable, as the claim is also listed either in the Optional Marketing Text or Marketing Claims sections of the labels for EPA Reg. Nos. 121-90, 121-91, 121-92, and 121-93, whose Active Ingredients statements also include Picaridin.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
