Product Name: Cutter Insect Repellent 15KA  
EPA Reg. No. 121-92  
Submission dated August 11, 2006

The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Section (3)(c)(7) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable subject to the comments and terms for conditional registration outlined below.

1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c) (5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for registration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes to EPA Reg. No 121-92
  - a. Remove "Cutter Insect Repellent 15KA is water [sweat] resistant.
  - b. Remove claim 1 - "New"
  - d. Remove claims 30, 31, and 33 from the label.
  - e. Remove claim number 35: "8 hours protection against Culex mosquitoes." from the label. Retain the approved 4.5 hour claim for mosquitoes. The eight hour claim would increase the reapplication interval despite the fact that a user will not be aware of the types of mosquitoes biting them. Other species may attempt to bite besides *Culex* spp.
3. The cited acute toxicity and product chemistry data are acceptable for both products. Updated DERs are attached.


4. The request to add biting flies, ticks, deer ticks, chiggers, no-see-ums and fleas is conditionally acceptable provided you agree to submit product specific efficacy data as described in draft EPA Product Performance Guideline 810.3700 for each pest by May 5, 2009. Testing protocols should be submitted by July 1, 2007.

Please refer to Kevin Sweeney's efficacy study review dated December 2, 2004 that describes data to be generated for each pest together with a mosquito field study.

5. With regard to product performance studies cited in your data matrix, I attached copies of the ethics reviews of two of the efficacy studies conducted with humans. Note that one study review requires you to submit additional information. For the other study, you must submit additional information so that it may be cited for registration purposes. Please respond to the findings of these ethics reviews by March 7, 2007. Additional product performance data will be required to support mosquito repellency claims for these products if these two studies cannot be used for registration purposes. If this is the case, these data should be submitted by May 5, 2009. If these data are necessary, test protocols should be submitted by July 1, 2007.

You should note that if you fail to satisfy any of the conditions imposed on this registration, e.g., you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadlines or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with the applicable test guidelines, or agreed upon protocols, EPA may issue notice to cancel this use under FIFRA 6(e).
