Delete from the label all directions and marketing claims saying the product may be used for light only. Delete all references to 3 modes of operation. Delete the statement "When pads are not in use, light can be exposed to rain". These statements detract from the precautionary statements required for this pesticide product.

Delete the following statements which detract from the Precautionary Statements: Brand name features an adjustable soft light to create your ideal patio ambiance. "...no cause for concern."

Delete the following comparative claim: No messy wax to drop or spill.

Delete the following statement which implies 100% efficacy: "...enjoy the outdoors in mosquito- and bug-free comfort for hours.

Revise directions for use in porches as follows: Do not use in enclosed porches.

Revise the Precautionary Statements as follows: Harmful if inhaled. Do not breathe vapor.

Insert in the Directions for Use, after the violation of Federal Law statement, a subsection entitled "Use Restrictions." Move the following statements to this subsection: Only for outdoor use as an insect repellent. Do not use indoors, in tents, in enclosed porches or any other enclosed area. Do not insert anything other than Cutter Insect Repellent EL repellent pads into the repellent chamber. Place light on a flat stable surface. Clean with a damp cloth only when the light is cool and inactive.

Move the instructions about batteries to the Directions for Use.

Add to the light label the EPA Reg. No. and the EPA Est. No. The Signal word Caution and the statement Keep out of Reach of Children must be placed so that they are visible when the light is in use.

In the instructions on pesticide disposal, provide instructions on disposing of used mats.

Revise the statement "Do not contaminate food" to read "Cover or remove exposed food." Place this statement in the Use Restrictions.

Graphics must exclude pictures of children and food.

Clarify what the term "up to" means when used with duration claims.

Delete protection claims as they imply 100% efficacy.

Label reference to a website makes the website collateral labeling. Collateral labeling that does not match the stamped label must be submitted for review as an amendment.

Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
