

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided:

1. You will submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No.121-100".
 - b) Remove claim #2 DEET, Fragrance Free
 - c) Remove claim #4 Does not contain DEET
 - d) Remove claim #5 Effective DEET Alternative
 - e) Remove claims for dengue fever.
 - f) Remove claim #41 No need to re-apply
 - g) Remove claim #45 Blocks Prevents Bites
 - h) Remove claim #50 Dye free
3. Submit the results of one year storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) to the Agency on completion. It is recommended that the observations be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, & 12 month intervals. The results must be submitted in a hard copy and an electronic format is also requested.

- 4. As agreed on in your email dated August 27, 2008, you will remove the label claims on application to clothing.
- 5. The request to add mosquitoes, biting flies, ticks, deer ticks, chiggers, gnats, no-see-ums and fleas to the product label is conditionally acceptable provided you submit product specific efficacy data as described in draft EPA Product Performance Guideline 810.3700 for each pest by May 5, 2009.
- 6. Add the following statements to the "First Aid" section:

If swallowed:

- Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately for treatment advice.
- Have the person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a doctor or Poison Control Center
- Do not give anything to an unconscious person.

7. Precautionary Statements: Change the signal word to "Caution". Add "Harmful if swallowed".


8. Change the Physical or Chemical Hazards Statement to read: "Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat & open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting."

9. Add: "Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin." to the Directions for Use section.

10. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label and the product chemistry data evaluation review are enclosed for your records. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 26, 2008 is acceptable and is the CSF of record for this product. The citation of the acute toxicology data in your data matrix referred to as "OWN" is acceptable in addition to the other acute toxicology studies cited because the tested formulation contained a higher % of active ingredient than found in the subject product.
