

BEEF & DAIRY SPRAY

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Hazardous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin.

Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

BEEF & DAIRY SPRAY is a specially prepared ready-to-use insecticide suitable for use in conventional hand, power or automatic spray equipment and in backrubbers. BEEF & DAIRY SPRAY is approved for use on lactating dairy animals.

Apply with hand, power or automatic equipment to moisten the hair only and not in excess of 2 fluid ounces daily per animal. Do not wet the skin due to possible skin irritations.

TO KILL STABLE FLIES, HORN FLIES, HOUSE FLIES, AND FACE FLIES ON DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE: Apply as a fine mist to all parts of the animal including legs, using one or two fluid ounces of spray per animal. The first week, apply daily. Thereafter, apply as necessary to maintain control.

FOR LICE CONTROL IN DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE: Make 1-2 applications of 3-3½ ounces of BEEF & DAIRY SPRAY at 14-day intervals as fine mist spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal. If material is applied by fogging or misting equipment, the maximum spraying time per animal is 20 seconds.

BACK AND FACE RUBBERS: To control horn flies and face flies use BEEF & DAIRY SPRAY in backrubbers and facerubbers. Use 1 gallon for each 20 linear feet of burlap backrubber. For automatic backrubbers, recharge the reservoir as needed. Animals must rub face on rubbers for face fly control.
