
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE — KEEP UPRIGHT WHILE MOVING AND IN STORAGE. Container equipped with a pressure relief closure. KEEP FROM FREEZ-ING. Store in original container only, in safe manner. DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

To be used in the disinfection of farm buildings and equipment which are used for poultry and livestock production. Especially suited for equipment which may harbor or spread many disease germs within the farm operation or to other farms. Dilute DC&R Disinfectant one ounce per gallon of water. Use as follows:

EQUIPMENT

Emoty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Then thorquality wet all exposed parts of the cleaned equipment used in the coultry or livestock operation.



All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

Immerse cleaned halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals; forks, all shovels and scrapers used for removing litter and manure and allow DC&R Disinfectant to " saturate all surfaces for 10 minutes. Do not spray onto feed to be consumed by animals.

When disinfecting trucks used for hauling poultry or livestock, it is desirable to rinse the truck cab a few minutes after the spraying is completed. Oo not rinse other parts of the truck. The release of formaldehyde is so slight that little or no odor can be detected. However, allow reasonable ventilation for animals transported following disinfection.



BUILDINGS

Evacuate all animals from buildings. Remove all fitter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chotes and other facilities and -77 fixtures occupied or traversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Wet all surfaces by allowing DC&R Disinfectant to saturate all surfaces for 10 minutes. Equipment inside the building (cages for laying hens, for example) should be first cleaned with soap or detergent, insed with water and then saturated as above with this product.



Ventilate buildings, cars, boats, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers with soap or detergent and rinse with potable water before reuse.
