DIRECTIONS FOR USE AS A DISINFECTANT

This disinfectant should always be diluted with water before using as the use of the concentrated disinfectant may cause irritation to the skin.

Sweep up all dust and dirt before applying MINTENE and be sure all infected areas are saturated with a solution of the Disinfectant.

Floors, Toilet Rooms, Bath Rooms, Laboratories, Urinals, Sinks, etc., should be cleaned thorough first and then use 2½ ounces MINTENE to each gallon of water and mop in regular manner. Can also be used in a sprayer for saturating surfaces that need to be disinfected and deodorized. Use the same quantity of Disinfectant to each gallon of water as recommended above.

For conditions that are exceptionally bad, such as dirty urinals, garbage cans, etc., be sure that the surfaces are thoroughly cleaned by use of strong cleaning solutions, to remove all dirt, then make sure Disinfectant comes in contact with all infected areas; disinfect with a solution of 5 ounces MINTENE per gallon.
