## FLIES ON CATTLE

Horse flies and horn flies on cattle can be controlled by using Pyrtox No. 20 Concentrate, full strength, in the treadle operated, automatic, micromist applicator developed by the Natural History Survey Division, State of Illinois. Adjust applicator to deliver 1/8 to 1/3 oz. per cow daily.


For hand application, apply two ounces of Pyrtox No. 20 Concentrate, full strength, per cow two to three times weekly (with hand sprayer) depending on the weather.

To prepare an effective space spray to control flies, gnats and mosquitoes, dilute Pyrtox No. 20 Concentrate in the proportions of 1 gallon with 19 gallons of deordorized or regular kerosene. To use, close doors and windows, employ a good sprayer and direct toward ceiling, filling the area treated with mist. Keep room closed 10 to 20 minutes. Repeat as required.

Frequent spraying of breeding places of flies, gnats and mosquitoes, such as stagnant water and garbage cans, also helps control these pests. Repeat treatment as needed.

Silverfish, fleas and ants also are controlled by spraying them directly or into hiding places occupied by them. Openings in walls, spaces behind sinks, cabinets and drawers, and other areas where these insects are found should be sprayed thoroughly, contacting all craw!ing insects which can be reached. The same treatment is recommended for roach control except the spray used should be prepared by mixing 1 gallon of Pyrtox No. 20 Concentrate with 6 gallons of deodorized or regular kerosene. Repeat as needed for control.
