SOIL INSECTS ON CROPS

GRANULAR APPLICATION: Apply T-H Heptachlor 20% Granular to soil at rates listed (Broadcast applications should be disked in immediately):

INSECT	POUNDS PER ACRE
Wireworm - Corn	2 1/2 pounds - Row Treatment 4 to 5 pounds - Broadcast 5 pounds - Row Treatment 10 pounds - Broadcast

HEPTACHLOR - FERTILIZER MIXTURES: Mix the required amount of T-H Heptachlor 20% Granular listed below with amount of fertilizer to be applied per acre. Apply either in a band (starter fertilizer), or broadcast and disk into soil before planting.

INSECT	POUNDS OF THE HEPTACHLOR 20% GRANULAR TO APPLY PER ACRE
Corn Rootworm	2 1/2 to 5 pounds
Wireworms - Corn	5 to 10 pounds
