TO KILL ALL VEGETATION: Mix 1 pint in 2 gallons of Kerosene and spray vegetation until wet. An effective general contact weed killer for waste areas, around buildings not landscaped, along paths, roadways and similar areas. Retreat surviving vegetation.

BEFORE USE READ WARNING AND NOTICE STATEMENTS CAREFULLY

TO KILL ANNUAL WEEDS (HENBIT, CHICK-WEED), in dormant Bermuda Grass lawns--Mix Penta Kil Concentrate with Kerosene in the following proportions:

<u>PENTA KIL CONCENTRATE</u>	<u>KEROSENE</u>
6 1/3 tablespoons (3 1/3 fl. oz.)	1 gallon
10 Fluid oz. (1 1/4 cups)	3 gallons
1 Pint	5 gallons

Place mixture in tank type pressure sprayer and spray weeds until wet.

T-H Penta Kil Concentrate--kerosene mixture should be sprayed on weedy Bermuda grass two or three weeks before the Bermuda starts to grow in spring (February--March in most areas). For best results apply on warm, sunny day. DO NOT USE after Bermuda Grass starts to green in the spring.

Do Not Use on Bluegrass, Bent grass or other winter lawn grasses. Do not get spray on ornaments, flowers or painted buildings
