DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For Early-Season Thrips, Flea Beetles and Cotton Fleahoppers. Also for Cotton Leafworms and Striped Blister Beetles: Apply 5 to 10 pounds per acre on appearance of insects.

For Mid- and Late-Season Boll Weevils, Bollworms, Fall Armyworms, Cotton Leaf Perforators, Leaf Rollers, Leafhoppers of d Tarnished Plant Bugs. Also for flight-to-moderate infestation of Lygus Buys in Western irrigated cotton: Apply 10 to 20 pounds per acre, depending on the size of the cotton and insect population level. Applications for Boll Weevils should be made every 5 to 7 days as long as control is necessary.

For Pink Bollworms: Apply 15 to 25 pounds per acre on a 5- to 7-day schedule depending on the size of the cotton and degree of infestation.

For Stink Bugs and Salt-Marsh Caterpillars: Apply 20 pounds per acre as needed.

For Grasshoppers: Apply 5 to 15 pounds per acre on appearance of insertion and their funding damage. The highest dosage should be used when Grasshoppers are mature or material is applied on partly defoliated plants.

Sevin does not control Spider Mites. Where infestations are encountered, use a recommended miticide.

-- Sevin may be applied after bolls open. Allow 7 days between last applica-- tion and grazing treated fields or harvesting crop residue for use as feed;or bedding for dairy or meat animals.
