DIRECTIONS

COTTON: For the control of early season thrips and cotton fleahopper, apply 10 to 20 pounds per acre on appearance of insects. For control of mid-and late-season boll weevil, bollworm, cotton leafworm, lygus and stink bugs and cotton leaf perforator, apply 20 to 25 lbs. per acre at from five to seven day intervals on appearance of insects. For salt-marsh caterpillar control: Apply 25 lbs. per acre SEVIN* may not be applied after bolls open. Do not graze treated fields or feed cotton trash to DAIRY or MEAT ANIMALS.

TOMATOES: To control tomato fruitworm, armyworms, hornworms, pinworm, russet mite and flea beetle, apply at 20 to 40 lbs. per acre, depending on size of plants and degree of infestation. No limitations prior to harvest.

GRAPES: To control grape leaf folder and grape leafhopper, use 20 to 25 lbs. per acre when first brook appears. Use 20 to 30 lbs. per acre on second and third broods of grape leaf folder. May be applied on grapes up to harvest.

DIRECTIONS (continued)

PEACHES, PLUMS, PRUNES: To control peach twig borer, use 40 to 50 lbs. per acre. May be used up to 1 day before harvest. Where mite infestations are encountered, use a recommended miticide. Sevin* is believed compatible with all pesticides commonly used on these crops except those of a highly alkaline nature.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN!
