RECOMMENDED USES

EGGPLANT, PEPPERS, POTATOES & TOMATOES. For control of  flea beetles, serpentine leaf miner, blister beetle and Colorado potato beetle, apply 10-15 lbs. per acre when insects appear and repeat if necessary. For control of  flea beetle larvae, white grubs and wireworms apply  25-50 lbs. per acre and work into soil at or before planting. For control of  cutworms and mole crickets apply 10-15 lbs. per acre on the soil around the base of the plants. Do not apply on  eggplant, peppers and tomatoes after edible parts begin to form.

PUBLIC HEALTH INSECT PESTS: For control of  roaches, (waterbugs), ants, silverfish, spiders, centipedes, scorpions, brown dog ticks, fleas, chiggers, wasps, box elder bugs and house crickets in outdoor areas, apply 20 lbs. per acre (1/2 lb. per 1000 sq. ft.) to outdoor area which are infested. For  Roaches and silverfish apply wherever insects are likely to crawl. For  ants thoroughly treat foundation walls or pillars for 6-8 inches up from ground ant trails and areas around door sills and

window frames where pests may enter the premises. For  spiders apply a liberal application in garages, sheds, to porches, under eaves and crawl-spaces of houses and porches without basements. For  wasps apply a liberal application to nesting sites, such as underneath eaves, porches, sheds and garages; apply after dark when insects have gone to rest so as to avoid possible stings. Do not apply to feedstuffs. Do not contaminate feed or drinking water.
