### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Measure the correct amount of Perthane E-4 and add to the sprayer tank while it is filling with the agitator running. Stir and mix thoroughly in hand sprayers. Thorough, full-coverage spray is important and nozzles should be adjusted properly for uniform distribution.


CHERRIES: Cherry fruit fly: Use 1 quart in 100 gallons of water. Thorough fullcoverage applications should be made beginning when the adult flies appear. Repeat application every 10 days until harvest time. Do not apply within 2 days of harvest. An additional spray after harvest is suggested, especially if high temperatures have kept flies active.

PEARS: For pear psylla control use 1 to 2 quarts per 100 gallons of water. (8 quarts per acre). Apply as prebloom and or postbloom sprays and up to 2 cover sprays. Allow 30 days between cover sprays. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

This material may be used in orchards inter planted with apples, but the apples may not be used for apple pomace for livestock feed.

LETTUCE-Leafhoppers, imported cabbage worms, cabbage loopers and alfalfa loopers (California): Use 1 quart per acre in 25 to 100 gallons of water in ground sprayers or in 5 gallons of water in aerial sprayers. Apply when the insects are found to be present, making thorough application. Repeat at weekly to 10-day intervals or as required for adequate insect control. In hand sprayers use 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.

SPINACH-Leafhoppers and cabbage loopers: Use 1 quart per acre in 25 to 100 gallons of water in ground sprayers or in 5 gallons of water in aerial sprayers. Apply when insects are first noted, making thorough application. Repeat applications at weekly to 10-days intervals as required for adequate insect control. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
