

**DIRECTIONS**

To control most weeds and grasses for extended periods on non-cropland areas such as industrial plant sites, parking lots, loading ramps and around storage buildings and the like apply 1 to 4 gallons per 1000 square feet after the most predominant weeds have emerged. No agitation is required. Bromo-Kil-D with Dedrift can be applied with standard spray equipment. For treating small areas, a tank type hand sprayer or sprinkling can may be used.

**NOTE:** Users should consult State Agricultural Experiment Stations or Extension Service Weed Specialists for recommendations as to use of this product in their particular area.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not apply directly to, or otherwise permit Bromo-Kil-D with Dedrift to contact susceptible plants as this product may injure cotton, beans, peas, grapes, flowers, fruit trees, ornamentals, or other desirable plants. **DIRECTIONS:**

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add .26 oz. to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use 6.5 oz. per 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add 6.5 oz. per 50,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

Pool-side Surfaces: After cleaning surfaces, use .5 oz. to ten gallons of water for sanitizing or .5 oz. to 5 gallons of water for disinfecting.
