DIRECTIONS FOR USE— WARNING: Do not throw these tablets directly into the pool, they may stain, bleach, or alter the color.

1. The filter system should be backwashed properly. If used and the pH is not between 7.2 and 7.6.
2. Initially the pool water should be conditioned with Stabilizer according to label directions.
3. The pool should first be superchlorinated so that a chlorine residual of 5 ppm available chlorine is obtained as determined by a test kit.
4. The feeder (see automatic tablets) or set feeder controls to maintain an average residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm. Refer to the back of a pool test kit.
5. These tablets are slow dissolving and are designed for use in the filter system. They should not be used in swimming pool filter systems. They should be used with automatic feeders only. 6. These tablets are acidic and will balance the high pH of pool water to about 7.4. Test the pH of your pool water regularly. A pH required to maintain a pH of 7.4. NEVER USE WATER WITH A pH ABOVE 7.6. High pH water will cause the eyes to burn and may damage the pool or filtration system. At pH above 8.0 no irritation also occurs and chlorine effectiveness rapidly diminished.
7. For long term use, place directly in the summer filter. If summer and winter pools are used, place in the winter filter. Do not use in the winter filter.
