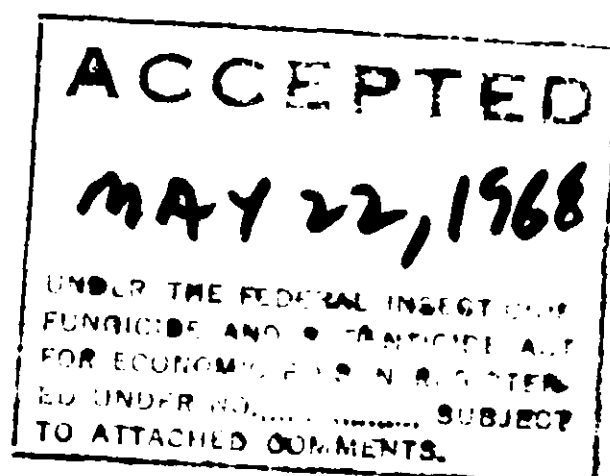


DIRECTIONS

For the control of leaf spot on peanuts apply at 7 to 10 day intervals beginning when spots first appear on basal leaves at the rate of 15 to 20 pounds per acre.

Armyworms, Velvet Bean Caterpillar and peanut worms on peanuts: begin applications at the rate of 20 to 30 pounds per acre when small worms first appear. During periods of severe infestations rates should be increased.

Thrips on peanuts: begin applications at the rate of 20 to 30 pounds per acre when small thrips first appear. Repeat the applications in 7 to 10 days. Apply additional dustings during the season as needed.
