



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ON COTTON: For early-season thrips, flea beetles and cotton fleahopper. Also for cotton leafworm and striped blister beetle: Apply 1 to 2 pounds of this product per acre on appearance of insects.

For mid and late-season boll weevil, bollworm, fall armyworm, cotton leaf perforator, leaf rollers, leafhoppers and tarnished plant bug. Also for light to moderate infestations of Lygus bugs in Western irrigated cotton.

Apply 2 to 4 pounds of this product per acre, depending on the size of the cotton and insect population level. Applications should be made every 5 to 7 days as long as control is necessary.

For pink bollworm:

Apply 2 to 4 pounds of this product per acre, depending on the size of the cotton and insect population level. Applications should be made every 5 to 7 days as long as control is necessary.

For stink bugs and salt marsh caterpillar:

Apply 2 to 4 pounds of this product per acre, depending on the size of the cotton and insect population level. Applications should be made every 5 to 7 days as long as control is necessary.

For thrips:

Apply 2 to 4 pounds of this product per acre, depending on the size of the cotton and insect population level. Applications should be made every 5 to 7 days as long as control is necessary.

Aphidid control: Apply 2 to 4 pounds of this product per acre, depending on the size of the cotton and insect population level. Applications should be made every 5 to 7 days as long as control is necessary.

2. To effectively apply this product by aircraft use standard Venturi type equipment with spray nozzles or Swathmaster type spreaders. Fly at a ground height (4 to 6 feet above the top of the plants as suggested) and maintain a constant swath width usually at 35 feet as indicated. For application with ground equipment use a broadcast spreader, pusher, or wheelbarrow. Apply the dust in a continuous stream with a normal walking pace. Do not apply in a "dribble" or "puff" application.
