STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DANGER. Highly Corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Do not use on humans or household pets. Keep out of reach of food and feed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Strong oxidizing agent. Mix only with water. Use clean, dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of heat, liberations of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible, isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in dry, cool, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Keep product dry in a tightly closed container when not in use. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

USE INSTRUCTIONS

This product is effective as a pool water disinfecting agent when used as directed. It is recommended that the pool be stabilized with cyanuric acid stabilizer to nullify the dissipation effect of sunlight on chlorine. When using this product, both chlorine and cyanuric acid stabilizer are being added to the water; however, it is necessary to initially stabilize pools with cyanuric acid stabilizer to effectively maintain the desired concentration of stabilizer. Follow the directions on the label for that product.

The filter system should be backwashed or properly cleaned and the pH adjusted between 7.2 and 7.6. Before using this product, it is recommended that the pool be superchlorinated so that a chlorine residual of between 1.0 and 3.0 ppm is obtained.

These tablets may be used in various type skimmers, proportioning mechanisms or feeders. Adjust whatever feeding mechanism that might be used to assure constant treatment level of 1.5-2.0 ppm available chlorine in the pool water (normally 1-2 oz.

of this product per 10,000 gallons daily) (two tablets is approximately one ounce). The regular use of a test kit will determine if further adjustment may be necessary to maintain the recommended level of available chlorine in the pool water.
