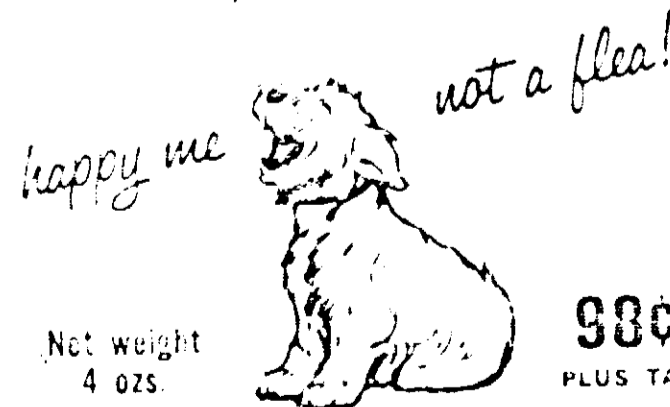

DIRECTIONS: Pierce hole in applicator cap to spray powder onto pet. Do not spray in face or eyes of animal. First apply a band of flea killer around pet's neck by brushing hair back with cap and applying powder down to skin. Then do rest of body in same manner.

For use on Dogs and Cats

KILLS FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS, LICE

If the animal has free run, treatments may have to be made every second or third week, but not more frequently than once a week. To avoid unnecessary applications, animal should be closely examined for fleas before reapplying. If the animal is confined to an area free of fleas, one treatment may be sufficient.



For control of fleas in kennels, pens, yards, lawns and under houses, remove manure or debris and dust contents of this can on area up to 180 square feet.
