

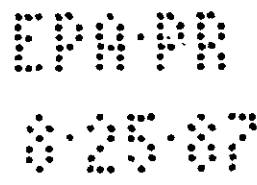

DIRECTIONS: Place bait in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Tear pieces of cardboard along perforated lines from carton. Put TERRO on them where ants are seen, such as edge of sinks, tubs, window sills, along baseboards and door entryways. First they come in large numbers, but soon disappear. Ants carry TERRO back to their nests, often eliminating the entire colony. Complete control may take up to two weeks. Repeat as necessary. Do not use in edible product areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
STORAGE: Do not store where children or animals may gain access.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash collection.
