The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

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SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

CLUSTER FLIES, HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES,

GNATS, BLACK FLIES, SKIPPER FLIES, BLOW FLIES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room, moving toward the door. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES SOWBUGS, PILLBUGS, AND LADYBUGS [or MULTICOLORED ASIAN LADY BEETLES (LADYBUGS)]: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.

BEDBUGS: Thoroughly inspect area of suspected bed bug infestation and note potential harborage sites or actual infestations. Remove and/or pick up clothing and other obstacles that may prevent thorough inspection or treatment. Remove and sanitize infested bedding (pillows and linens) clothing or other items. Apply on mattresses as a spot treatment to mattress, seams, edges, buttons, and tufts of bed only. Do not use directly on pillows bed linens or clothes. Do not saturate the mattress and do not treat entire surface area of mattress. Allow mattress to dry thoroughly before replacing pillow and/or bed linens.

Bed Bugs may also harbor in area of the room away from the bed. Apply as crack and crevice or spot application where evidence of bed bugs occurs. This includes bed frames box springs inside empty drawers and clothes, closets, night stands, and other furniture in the room carpet edges high and low wall moldings (such as floor molding or window casings), wall voids behind wall hangings, and mirrors wall paper edges and popcorn ceilings. Remove all clothes and other articles from dressers or closets before application. Take bed apart. Treat joints and channels if hollow such as square or round tubing and see that interior framework is treated. Allow all treated areas to dry thoroughly before use.

This product is not recommended for use as a sole protection against bed bugs. If evidence of bed bugs is found in/on mattresses, use this product as part of an integrated pest management program to control bed bugs.

TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

FLEAS IN BUILDINGS - SPACE SPRAY: Hold can 36 inches above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq. ft. making sure that all floor, sofa and chair surfaces are contacted. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes. Open and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment after 7 days or if reinfestation occurs.

FLEAS & TICKS (ADULTS AND LARVAE): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and doorframes. Apply on infested mattresses as a spot treatment to mattress seams edges buttons and tufts of bed only. Do not use directly on pillows bed linens or clothes. Do not saturate the mattress and do not treat entire surface area of mattress Allow mattress to dry thoroughly before replacing pillow and/or bed linens. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

OUTDOOR USE

USE RESTRICTIONS FOR OUTDOOR USE

Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs.

This product is not for use in outdoor residential misting systems (indoors or outdoors).

Do not make application during rain.

Do not water the treated area to the point of run off.

Do not wet plants to the point of run off or drip.

Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours).

Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

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Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).

Do not use this product directly on domestic (companion) animals (dogs, cats, puppies, or kittens).

All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- (1) Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
- (2) Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
- (3) Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
- (4) Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch:
- (5) Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.) up to 2 feet above ground level;
- (6) Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn turf, mulch, or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds. Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly into sewers or storm drains or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to storm sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur Do not allow this product to enter any drain during or after application. FLYING INSECTS: *Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Small Flying Moths.* Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.

CRAWLING INSECTS: *Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes,* and *Silverfish*. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

TO KILL ORNAMENTAL GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill **Japanese Beetles** hit by spray, as well as **Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites** and **Leafminers**.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jews and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against *Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites* and *Army Worms*. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion.

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Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.
