The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Deltamethrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

CAUTION

Environmental Hazards

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is no predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For both indoor and outdoor use.

General Precautions & Use Restrictions

- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift.
- Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
- Do not apply as a space spray.
- Do not make outdoor applications during rain.
- Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application.
- Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces or wash them before use.
- Do not apply directly into sewers or drains or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.
- Outdoor applications to building foundations are permitted up to a maximum height of 2feet. Other than applications to building foundations, all listed outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice applications, only. Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2ft. by 1 ft or 4 ft by 0.5 ft.).
- Do not use on edible crops.
- Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems.

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This product works in two ways:

- 1) it kills bugs [pests, insects] fast on contact; and
- 2) its residual action keeps on killing *German Cockroaches* and *Houseflies* for up to 12 weeks [3 months] after you spray.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. Hold container upright. Remove protective cap and direct spray away from face. Hold can 12-15 inches from surface being sprayed. Press button down and spray as directed. Test product in an inconspicuous area before applying. Spray until surface is slightly wet but not to the point of run-off. Over application may cause damage. Will not stain surfaces or fabrics where water alone causes no damage.

[Optional use directions]

[SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Gently rotate top to open and close. Hold can upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.]

[For crack & crevice treatments, firmly insert extension tube into nozzle.]

Cockroaches [American and German Cockroaches] [(Including Adult and Immature Stages of Both Non-Resistant and Organophosphate and Carbamate Resistant Strains)], Ants [Carpenter, Fire, Harvester, Argentine, and Pharaoh Ants], Asian Lady Bird Beetle (Lady Bugs), Beetles, Boxelder Bugs, Centipedes, Crickets, Firebrats, Fleas, Palmetto Bugs (Waterbugs), Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders [Black Widow, Brown Recluse and Hobo Spiders], and Ticks: Apply as a general surface, spot or crack & crevice treatment to all non-food areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices, hidden areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases and similar areas. When pests are driven out, spray directly.

[Roaches: Spray in cracks and crevices, around baseboards and other hiding places until wet. When driven out, spray bugs directly. Repeat treatment if re-infestation occurs, but do not apply more than once per week.]

Ants: Spray around ant trails and around doors and windows and other places where ants enter the house. Repeat [treatment] if re-infestation occurs, but do not apply more than once per week.

Carpenter Ants: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Spray into infested wood through existing openings. Repeat [treatment] after 4 weeks or if re-infestation occurs, but do not apply more than once per week.

Ticks (Including Ticks Which May Carry Lyme Disease) and Fleas ON SURFACES: Remove pet bedding and destroy or clean thoroughly. Spray pet resting quarters. Adult Fleas contacted by spray will be killed. Put fresh bedding down once spray has dried. Do not spray animals directly. For best results, pets should be treated with an appropriate flea and/or tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to return to treated area. Spray rugs and carpets where infestations are bad. Delicate fabrics should be tested for staining in an inconspicuous area prior to use. Repeat [treatment] after 2-4 weeks or if reinfestation occurs, but do not apply more than once per week.

Spiders [Black Widow, Brown Recluse and Hobo Spiders]: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas where these pests are found. Spray spiders directly for best results.

Bedbugs: Remove and wash linens. Take bed apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Apply to the interior of the frame. Allow all articles to dry before remaking bed.

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Centipedes, Ground Beetles, Pillbugs, Sowbugs, Scorpions and Ticks: Apply around doors and windows, baseboards, storage areas and other places where these pests are found.

Asian Lady Bird Beetles (Lady Bugs): Spray areas where bugs crawl or are at rest, around doors, windows and areas where insects can enter the home.

[Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Earwigs: Apply to areas where these pests are found.]

PANTRY PESTS: Beetles, Moths, Weevils, [Flour Beetles (Red and Confused), Grain Beetles (Rusty, Merchant and Saw-Toothed), Chocolate Moths, Indian Meal Moths, Angoumois Grain Moths, Mediterranean Flour Moths, Cigarette Beetles, Drugstore Beetles, Rice Weevils, Lesser Grain Borers, Spider Beetles, Grain Mites and Tobacco Moths]: Treat exposed stages.

Remove all food-stuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of shelf paper, food and utensils. Repeat [treatment] if re-infestation occurs, but do not apply more than once per week.

Carpet Beetles [(Black, Furniture and Varied)] and Dermestid Beetles [(Hide, Larder, Leather)]: Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found. Fabrics should be tested for staining in an inconspicuous area prior to use. Repeat [treatment] if re-infestation occurs, but do not apply more than once per week.

[Webbing] Clothes Moths: Use this product as a crack and crevice treatment in closets and other storage areas where these pests are found. This is will not control moth larvae already on clothes. Do not apply to clothing. Repeat [treatment] if re-infestation occurs, but do not apply more than once per week.

OUTDOORS:

Point nozzle away from face. Hold can on a slight downward angle, approximately 12 - 15 inches from surface to be sprayed...

Application Restrictions for Outdoor Use

All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- (1) Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
- (2) Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn);
- (3) Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
- (4) Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- (5) Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.) up to 2 feet above ground level;
- (6) Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn turf, mulch, or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rives, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds. Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.

Do not apply or irrigate to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application. Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph.

Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

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PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES: To control infestations of outdoor pests such as *Ants, Cockroaches, Ticks* and *Spiders*, spray foundation of building where these insects [pests, bugs] are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, picnic areas, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment weekly if necessary, but do not apply more than once per week.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants [(Including Fire, Pharaoh, Carpenter, Argentine, Harvester Ants)], [American and German] Cockroaches, Centipedes, Scorpions, Crickets, Palmetto/Waterbugs, Spiders [Including Black Widow, Brown Recluse and Hobo Spiders] Asian Lady Bird Beetles (Lady Bugs), Sowbugs, Earwigs, Boxelder Bugs and Beetles. Spray insects [bugs, pests] directly.

Ticks (Including Lone Star Ticks, Deer Ticks (which may carry Lyme disease), Black Legged Ticks): Spray areas where these pests are found.

Ants [(Including Carpenter, Harvester, Pharaoh, Argentine, and Fire Ants)]: Spray around ant trails and hills. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray on and around debris. Spray ants directly whenever possible. Repeat if ants return, but do not apply more than once per week.

[Ants: Spray ant trails and hills. If nest can be located, spray surface of nest until wet.]

Asian Lady Bird Beetles (Lady Bugs): Spray areas where pests are found. If spraying outside walls of homes, especially vinyl or aluminum siding, test a small area first for possible staining.

Wasps, Hornets and Bees: Spray individuals directly and vacate area. Do not treat whole nests with this product.

FLYING INSECTS: *Houseflies, Gnats, Mosquitoes* and *Moths*: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of windows, window and door frames, screens and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, surfaces around light fixtures and cords, railings, etc. where these insects may rest. Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Retreat weekly or when insects return, but do not apply more than once per week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from [inaccessible to] children and pets and away from heat, sparks and open flame. [Protect from freezing.] [Do not freeze.] [Do not transport or store below 32°F.]

Container Disposal: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! *If empty:* Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. [This container may be recycled in aerosol recycling centers. At present, there are only a few such centers in the country. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label.] *If partly filled:* Do not pour or dispose down-the-drain or sewer. Call your local solid waste agency for local disposal options.
