

CLEANING STEPS

MILKING MACHINES and ACCESSORY PARTS

1. Draw 100 deg. F. water through the machine until water runs clear.
2. Draw Count-Down solution (1 oz. per 2 gals. water) through machine to remove residual milk.
3. Dismantle and stiff brush all parts with Count-Down solution in 100 F. water.
4. Rinse with clear water and hang to drain dry.

COW'S UDDERS—MILKER'S HANDS

1. Wash hands thoroughly with Count-Down solution (1 oz. per 2 gals. water).
2. Submerge clean cloth or paper towel in warm standard Count-Down solution.
3. Gently wash udders and teats. Damp dry with squeezed towel.
4. Make new solution for every eight cows prepared for milking.

FARM BULK TANKS


1. Rinse thoroughly right after draining with 100 deg. F. water.
2. Brush inner and outer surfaces with 200 p.p.m. Count-Down solution (1 oz. per each 2 gals. of water.)
3. Dismantle the valve and wash with same solution. Reassemble valve and drain dry tank.
4. If separate sanitize rinse required, rinse with warm water and sanitize as required. Follow local health regulations.

PAILS, STRAINERS and GENERAL CLEANING

1. Rinse thoroughly with 100 deg. F. water to remove residual milk.
2. Prepare Count-Down solution and stiff brush all surfaces. (1 oz. per 2 gals. of water.)
3. Rinse with clear water and drain dry. Store for contact protection from dust, etc.
4. Before using rinse with standard 200 p.p.m. Count-Down solution (1 oz. per 2 gals. of water).




