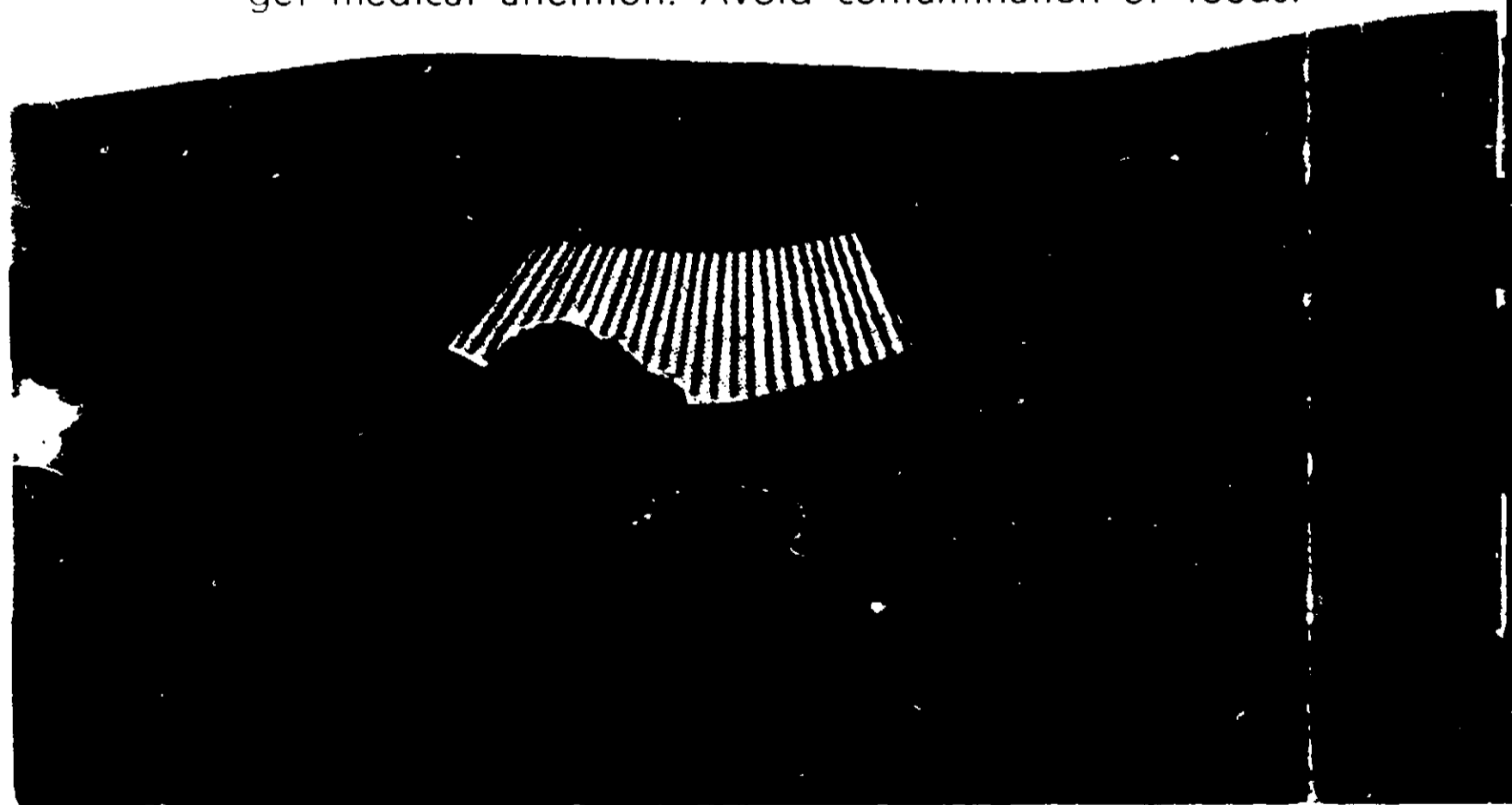
### AN-O-DINE FOR MILKERS, FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS

1. Follow each milking or processing period by flushing with cold to warm water until all residual milk or food is rinsed free.
2. Using 1 oz. to 5 gallons (25 ppm of available iodine) of lukewarm water, break all parts of the milker or equipment—soak in tank.
3. Brush-wash all soil from milker. Wash other utensils such as pails, strainers, etc., in the solution after the milker is washed. Allow for two-minute exposure.

AN-O-DINE is effective in water up to 2,000 ppm. of hardness. Dark brown indicates strong solutions and light yellow color indicates solution needs strengthening. Effective in water from 40° F. to 200° F.

**AN-O-DINE FOR BULK TANKS**

1. Hose flush with 90° water until milk residual is gone.
2. Using 1 oz. of **AN-O-DINE** to 5 gallons of cold water (25 ppm available iodine) wash tank carefully.
3. Brush stubborn areas of tank, drain and leave for two minute exposure time. (Sanitize with spraygun or sprinkler a 25 ppm solution before using.)

**AN-O-DINE FOR UDDERS**

1. Using 1/2 oz. in 2 1/2 gals. of lukewarm solution submerge one clean towel for each cow.
2. Carefully wash udder, teats and destroy towel.

**AN-O-DINE FOR MILKSTONE REMOVAL**

1. A solution of 1 qt. **AN-O-DINE** to 1 quart warm water will remove any yellow milkstone that shows up during cleaning period.
2. Brush surface with Concentrate; allow two-minute reaction time.
3. Brush, rinse and drain dry.

**AN-O-DINE** will prevent future milkstone buildup.

**AN-O-DINE GERMICIDAL TABLE OF DILUTION**

- 1 oz. **AN-O-DINE** to 2 1/2 gallons equals 50 ppm available iodine
- 1 oz. **AN-O-DINE** to 5 gallons equals 25 ppm available iodine
