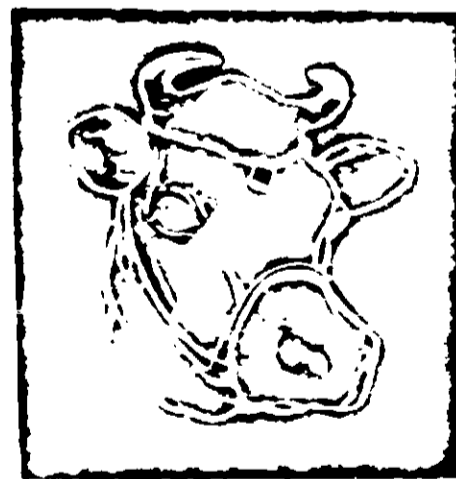
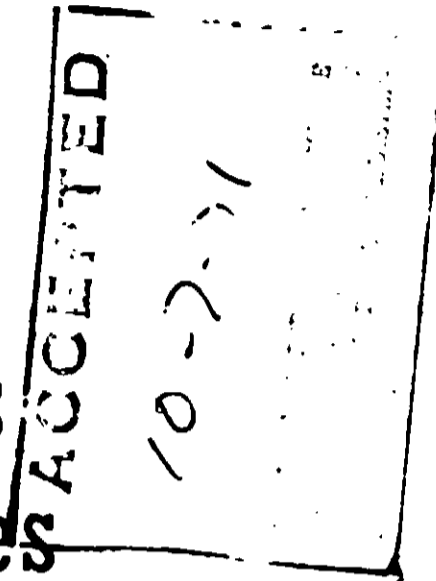

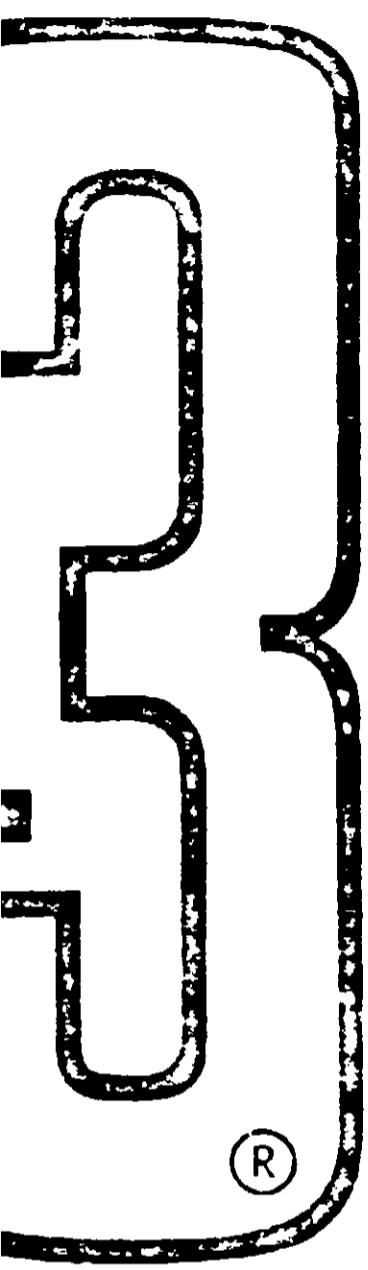

# LETHAL 13

## DAIRY INSECTICIDE

### DIRECTIONS:

**IN BARN** Close all doors and windows prior to milking. Suspend spraying in the air so it settles gradually to the floor. Keep closed for 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary for control of flies, mosquitoes and gnats. Apply at rate of 1 pint per 8,000 cubic feet.

**HORN FLIES, STABLE FLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS** Use a good hand or machine sprayer and spray as a mist. Wear minimum 1 to 2 ounces of LETHAL 13 to a 1/2 gallon. Spray before milking for best results. Treat on flies, stable flies, mosquitoes and gnats. Particular attention should be taken to cover the animal's eyes and face especially the ears and belly. Apply to the inside of the animal's head, around the eyes, ears and mouth. Do not apply within one week of calving. Use at least one 2 1/2 ounce daily application. Care should be taken that the spray does not come in contact with the udder. Treat the udder with a disinfectant before milking. Do not spray directly on the animal's face.

**IN BARN FOGGER** This is a contact insecticide. One ounce per 100 cubic feet of space. Apply in the air and let settle. Do not spray directly on animals. Use in a well-ventilated area. Do not use in a confined space.

**PIGS, HORSES, KENNELS AND HORSE BARN** Spray LETHAL 13 in a fine mist. Do not spray directly on animals. Use in a well-ventilated area. Do not use in a confined space. Apply at rate of 1 pint per 8,000 cubic feet.

**SANITATION** LETHAL 13 will be more effective when barns are kept clean and free of garbage, manure, and other animal waste.

**WARNING:** Harmful or Fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Wear protective clothing. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Do not use on water, feed, milk or milking equipment. Do not store in temperatures over 120 degrees F. Keep well sealed when not in use. Do not apply regularly to calves under 6 months of age. Ring-necked cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates. Atropine is antidote. CPRAM is also antidote and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

**EMPTY CONTAINER** Do not reuse empty container. Wash thoroughly with water and detergent and dispose of it.

This insecticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate water by washing the container or contents in streams or other bodies of water.

Do not use about sprayer or other equipment for 24 hours.
