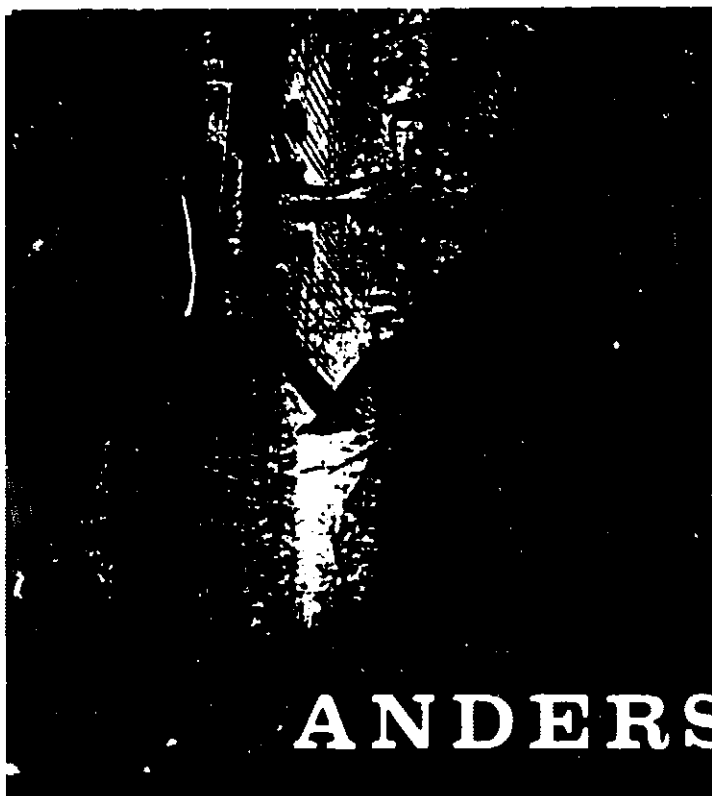

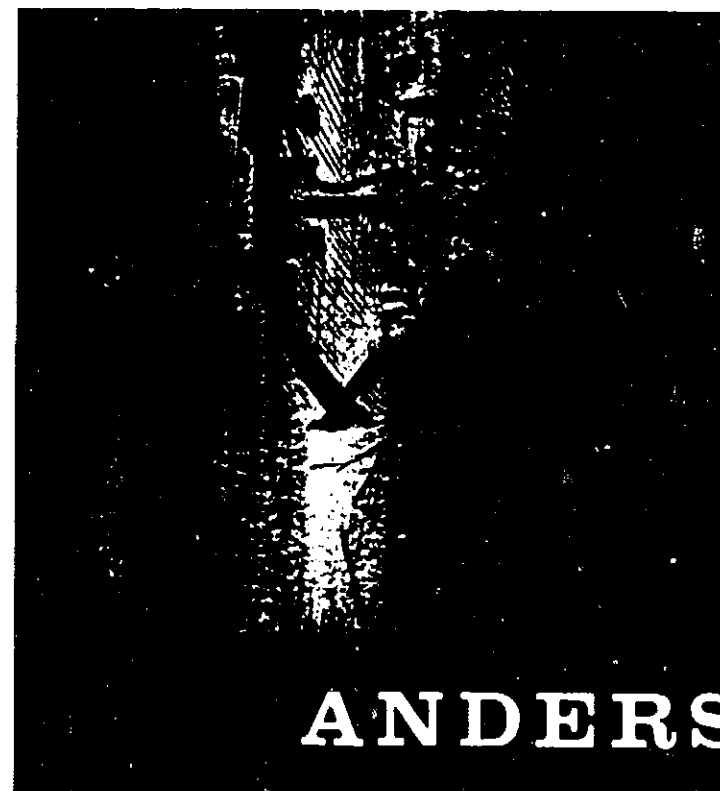

Directions For Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Sanitizing Pre-cleaned Food Processing, Beverage and Dairy Equipment:

1. Equipment, surfaces and articles must be pre-cleaned before applying sanitizing solution.
2. Following the cleaning cycle the equipment, etc. must be rinsed with potable water.
3. Sanitize with AN-TEC 110 solution containing 1 oz. to 4 gallons water (260 ppm dodecyl benzene sulfonic acid). Apply sanitizing solution by circulating or spraying. Allow 2 minutes contact time. When used at this concentration, AN-TEC 110 does not require a final potable water rinse.
4. For manual operations, a fresh use solution should be prepared daily or when the solution becomes diluted or soiled. For mechanical applications, the use solution may not be reused for sanitizing but may be reused for cleaning purposes.
5. Allow equipment to drain and foam to dissipate for at least 10 minutes before using equipment.

IMPORTANT: Always follow State and Local Health Department's Regulations.

This product fulfills the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance "1965" recommendations of the U. S. Public Health Service when tested by A.O.A.C. Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Official Method.
