

BLEACH

**KEEP IN A COOL PLACE. DO NOT USE ON SILK OR WOOL.
USE ON WHITE AND FAST-COLORS ONLY.**

DIRECTIONS

TUB WASHING: Use one tablespoon LETS BLEACH to each gallon of warm water, add soap or washing powder and let clothes soak half-hour or overnight. Wash and rinse well.

WASHING MACHINE: Add one-half cup LETS BLEACH diluted with a pint of water in either wash-water or in the first deep-rinse, whichever is more convenient.

BABIES' CLOTHES: Especially suitable for laundering infants' white cotton and linen garments, using one-half cup LETS BLEACH in wash-water.

BLEACHING: Add one tablespoon LETS BLEACH to each gallon of rinse water, cold or lukewarm. Soak clothes for 15 minutes, then rinse several times in clear water. If directions for laundering have been followed, use of LETS BLEACH in rinse water is not always necessary.

REMOVING STAINS: Ink, fruit, vegetable, flower, grass, tea, and coffee stains, also scorch and mildew, may be removed from white or color-fast cotton or linen by soaking from 5 to 15 minutes in a solution of two tablespoons LETS BLEACH in a quart of cold water. Repeat if necessary and rinse well. Lemon juice or vinegar will remove any brown spots remaining after removing stains.

CLEANING & DEODORIZING: Refrigerators, enamelware, bathtubs, wash-bowls, linoleum, tile floors may be cleaned by washing with a solution of two or three tablespoons of LETS BLEACH to a quart of water, adding soap if desired. Wash the surface, allowing the solution to remain a few minutes, then rinse well with clear water. Most spots and stains will disappear.

DISINFECTING: To make a disinfecting solution for the treatment of previously cleaned food handling equipment, utensils, and dishes, add one tablespoon LETS BLEACH to each gallon lukewarm water and mix well. Immerse articles to be disinfected in this solution after they have been cleaned thoroughly with a suitable detergent.

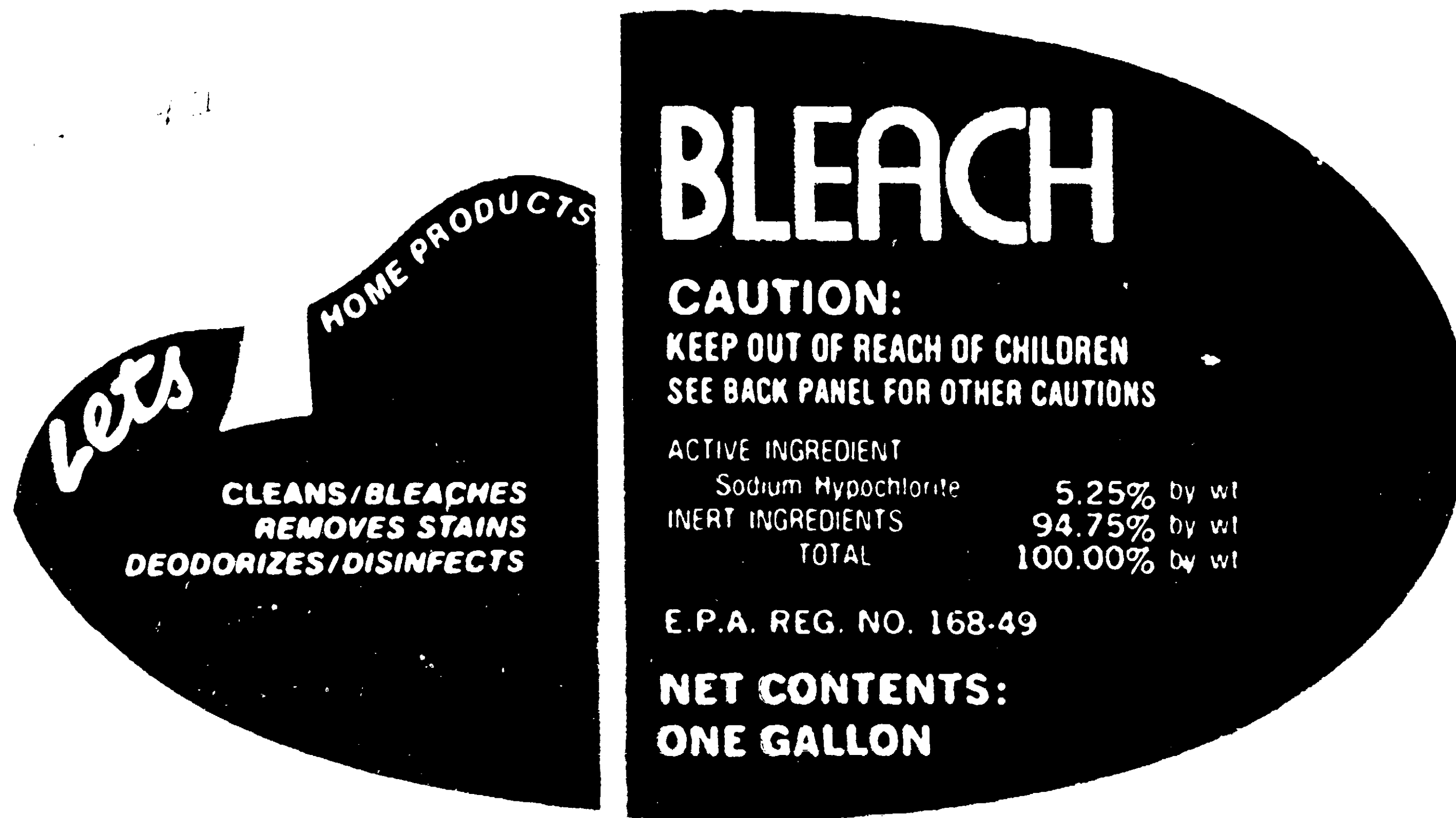

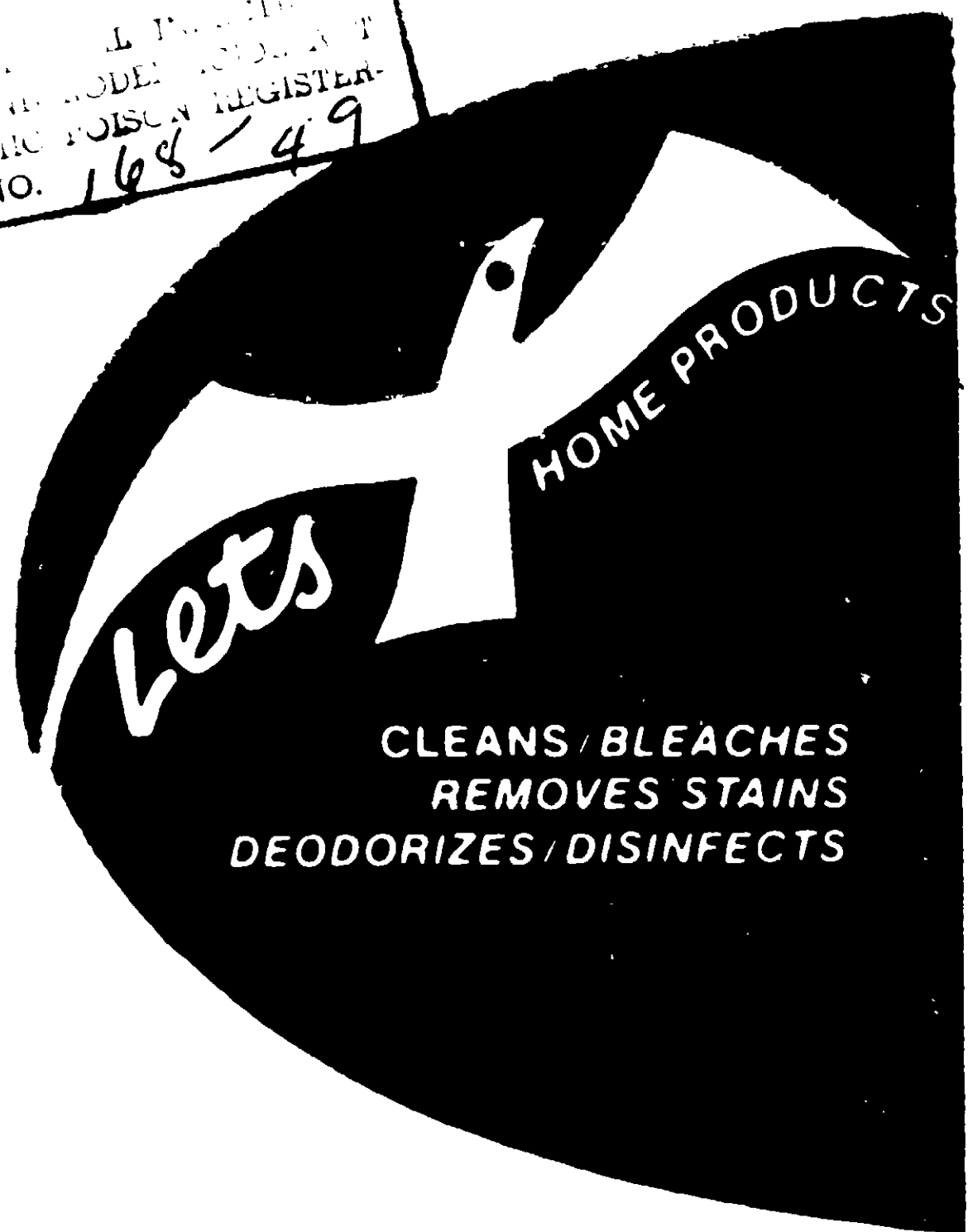
