RESIDUAL SPRAY IN FLOUR MILLS AND GRAIN, RICE AND OTHER CEREAL STORAGE (Saw Toothed Beetles, Flat Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Granary Weevils) - As a residual spray application to woodwork in bins and other grain storages, which previously have been thoroughly cleaned, use 10 gallons per 100 gallons of water (1/2 gallon to 5 gallons of water). Apply by means of knapsack, garden or power sprayer at the rate of 2 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. for control of the above insects which may emerge from burrows and cracks of the woodwork after cleaning.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed.
Avoid inhalation and prolonged contact with the skin.
Wash with soap and water.
Remove spray deposits from plant material consumed as food.

FLAMMABLE MIXTURE: Keep away from heat or open flame.

This product will kill fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, and ponds.
