# WEEDS CONTROLLED

This product is a contact herbicide useful for controlling broadleaf weeds and grasses, such as puncturevine, wild mustard, wild oats, chickweed, sandbur, common ragweed, pigweed, lambaquarter, common plaintain, prostrate spurge, barnyardgrass, glant foxtail, yellow foxtail and to top-kill certain perennials such as Johnsongrass, Dal Jurass and nutsedge.

#### LAWN RENOVATION

The area to be treated should be mowed before treatment. Reapply five days later if green areas reappear. When foliage is all brown, matted areas should be raked and bare areas scarified. About five days after last treatment, water thoroughly and then seed at rate recommended for new lawns. Seed must be raked into soil. Keep seeded areas well watered.
