Onions, Garlics, Shallots, Leeks, Scallions, Potatoes, Sweet Potatoes, Iris, Lilies, Tulips,
Crocus, Snowdrops.

Insects: Helps control Thrips, Wireworms, Narcissus Bulb Fly (larvae)

STORAGE TREATMENT: Helps control Thrips and Storage Rot.

1. Avoid bruising bulbs when dipping and cleaning.
2. Discard and destroy all diseased, scarred or broken bulbs.
3. Dip bulbs after cleaning and again before planting as recommended by State Extension Service Specialists.
4. After bulbs are cleaned and cured and before storage, dust them as follows:
Shake in sack or container with just sufficient amount of dust to thoroughly coat all bulbs.
5. Do not treat bulbs that are scarred or broken or that have their husk or covering removed.

SOIL TREATMENT: BEFORE PLANTING

1. Use 1 lb. per 200 sq. ft. of soil area.
2. Treat only the actual planting area.
3. Follow "Worked into Soil" directions as under General Directions.
4. For thrips on plants, follow standard spray or dust program.

PLANTING TREATMENT:

1. Dust bulbs just before planting, as noted under Storage Treatment.
2. Dust planting hole or furrow lightly but evenly (approximately 1 oz. of dust per 2 sq. ft. of planting soil area).
3. Do not mix dust into the soil. Close hole or furrow in usual manner.
