DIRECTIONS FOR UDDER WASHING AND SANITIZING

- 1. For each dow to be milked, place one clean towel in plastic bucket containing fresh, warm 25 ppm titratable iodine solution (½ oz. TAME to a 10-quart pail).
- 2. Wash udder; discard towel in second bucket.
- 3. Examine each quarter with strip cup.


