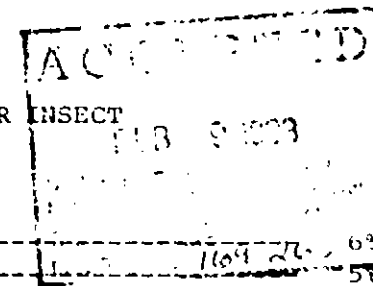

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water. Remove any contaminated clothing. IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with water. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. DO NOT USE 2-PAM, OPIATES OR CHOLINESTERASE-INHIBITING DRUGS.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Apply this product only as specified on this label. PROTECT BEES: This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on treated areas. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting the crop, cover crop, or weeds blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOTICE: When mixing or loading this product, all workers must wear the following protective clothing: long pants, long-sleeved shirt, gloves, hat and boots.

CAUTION: Avoid excessive application. Some phytotoxicity may occur on tender foliage in the presence of rain or high humidity of several days' duration following application.

PREHARVEST INTERVAL: Follow the time interval in days between last application and harvest indicated by the number in () following each crop. A (0) indicates this product may be applied up to and including day of harvest.

APPLICATION: Begin dusting when insects or diseases first appear and apply on a regular 7 to 10-day schedule or as necessary for good control. Apply at the rate of 20 to 40 pounds per acre or 1 to 2 ounces to 50 feet of row.

BEANS (7): Mexican bean beetle, leafhoppers, stink bug, downy mildew and rust.

CUCUMBERS (5), SQUASH (5), PUMPKINS (0), MELONS (5): Cucumber beetle, flea beetle, pickleworm, melonworm, squash bug, downy mildew, alternaria leaf spot and anthracnose.

TOMATOES (5), EGGPLANTS (0), PEPPERS (0): European corn borer, fall armyworm, flea beetles, tomato fruitworm, tomato hornworm, stink bug, early blight, late blight, anthracnose, stemphylium and cladosporium grey mold on tomatoes; and the insects listed plus cercospora leaf spot and anthracnose on eggplants and peppers. Under severe tomato hornworm, European corn borer and stink bug infestations, it may be necessary to use SECURITY BIG 10 DUST.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Store in cool, dry place. Keep away from fire and sparks. Do not allow to become wet or overheated during storage or chemical changes may occur which would impair the fungicidal effectiveness of this product. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to federal, state or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty container by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.
