GENERAL INFORMATION

BO-RID Soil Sterilant, when used at rates of 200 lbs. per acre, is an effective general herbicide for the control of most annual and perennial grasses and weeds of non-cropland areas where bare ground is desired.

BO-RID Soil Sterilant may be used at any time of year for general vegetation control, providing the chemical is moved to the root zone by rainfall or artificial means.

CAUTION Keep out of reach of children. (See back of bag for additional cautions)

Best results are obtained if BO-RID Soil Sterilant can be applied pre-emergence (before growth starts) The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall and other conditions.

BO-RID Soil Sterilant is formulated for dry application in power and hand operated spreading equipment. Effects of applications are usually slow to appear and may not become evident until the herbicide has been carried to the root zone by moisture. Because the effectiveness of BO-RID Soil Sterilant varies with environmental conditions and species of vegetation, user should consult expert station or extension service weed specialists for suggestions for use under local conditions.


(FRONT SIDE)

DIRECTIONS

Use a mechanical spreader or other device which will spread the required amount of BO-RID SOIL STERILANT evenly over the area to be treated. BO-RID SOIL STERILANT should be applied before growth starts to take advantage of early season moisture in the soil.

GENERAL VEGETATION CONTROL: To control most annual and perennial weeds for extended periods of time on non-cropland such as UTILITY, HIGHWAY, PIPE-LINE and RAILROAD RIGHTS OF WAY, PETROLEUM TANK FARMS, LUMBER YARDS, STORAGE AREAS, DRAINAGE DITCHES, and INDUSTRIAL PLANT SITES, apply BO-RID STERILANT at 200 pounds per acre. A repeat

spot treatment may be required where a longer period of control is desired. Second year spot treatment is usually satisfactory following a first year thorough application.

IMPORTANT

Do not apply to locations from which BO-RID SOIL STERILANT may be washed or moved into contact with roots of valuable plants. Apply with care to prevent drift of dry powder onto valuable plants or cropland. Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes. Keep from contact with fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides and seeds. Do not use spreaders with which BO-RID SOIL STERILANT has been applied for spreading insecticides, fungicides and fertilizers. Thoroughly clean application equipment after use to prevent possible contamination of selective herbicides subsequently used. Do not drain or flush spreader near lawns, valuable trees or other plants or on areas into which their roots may extend.
