Ro-Rid B-1 Bromachl Weed Killer is a spray on nonperennial areas. It is an herbicide, and is particularly effective on weeds, and may not become apparent in the weeds by moisture. The degree of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall for Ro-Rid B-1, after mixing in water, is no different. Do not use with aluminum.

Before spraying, calibrate equipment to measure area to be treated. Measure volume of water. After Bo-Rid B-1 is in the spray solution is not required. Use a fixed boom power sprayer for application with a hand-gun sprayer, a tank-type hand sprayer or sprayer.

To control most weeds for an extended HIGHWAY and PIPELINE RIGHT OF WAY AREAS, and INDUSTRIAL PLANT SITES Apply 3 to 6 gals. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre. Control weeds such as crabgrass, cheatgrass, wild oats, crabgrass, cheatgrass and turkey mullein. When applied as 1 1/2 gal. per acre control many short term control in higher rainfall areas. Apply 6 to 12 gals. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre. Control weeds such as smooth brome, bahiagrass, bluegrass, dog fennel, goldenrod, plantain and clover. Apply 4.5 gals. per acre control many OTHER HARD-TO-KILL PERENNIAL WEEDS such as, Vaseygrass, setgrass, brome, etc. (usually, less than 4 inches) or the West. Bo-Rid B-1 will not provide control of weeds such as Johnsongrass. Use the higher levels of the dosage (matter or carbon).
Retreatment—Apply 1.5 to 6 gals. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre where weed growth has been controlled. For Small Areas—5 or 10 gal. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Bo-Rid B-1 Insecticide Weed-Killer is a water-soluble concentrate stored in water and applied as a spray on cropland areas. It is an effective general herbicide for control of many annual and perennial weeds, particularly annual broadleaf weeds and grasses. Effects are slow to appear and they are not always apparent until the following spring. The herbicide kills the weeds by moisture, the degree of control and duration of effect varies with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall, and other conditions. Bo-Rid B-1 is effective on weeds in water, which may be a problem for some and may be a source of data for control of weeds in water. Bo-Rid B-1 is not a contact herbicide and is not a spray-on herbicide.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not use in violation of Federal Law to the extent prohibited in a manner inconsistent with the label thereon.

Apply Bo-Rid B-1 just before or during the period of active growth of weeds. If dense growth is present, results will be improved if vegetation is mowed before treatment. Do not apply when ground is frozen.

Before spraying, calibrate equipment to determine quantity of water necessary to uniformly cover the area to be treated. Measure the proper amount of Bo-Rid B-1 and mix into the necessary volume of water. After Bo-Rid B-1 has been thoroughly mixed in the spray tank, agitation of the spray solution is not required.

Use a mechanical power sprayer properly calibrated to a constant speed and rate of delivery. For application with a hand-gun sprayer, use at least 20 gals. spray per acre. For treating small areas, a tank-type hand sprayer or sprinkling can may be used.

WEED CONTROL

To control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas such as RAILROAD, HIGHWAY and RIVERBANK RIGHT OF WAYS, PETROLEUM TANK FIELDS, LUMBERYARDS, STORAGE AREAS, and NEARBY FARM SITES.

Apply 1 to 2 gals. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre to control ANNUAL WEEDS and GRASSES such as foxtail, barnyard grass, wild radish, hairy vetch, alfalfa, bromegrass, ryegrass, and smartweed, puncturevine, prostrate knotweed, and others. When applied in a pre-treatment manner, Bo-Rid B-1 will control many annual weeds and grasses in low rainfall areas. Bo-Rid B-1 will also control many annual weeds and grasses in high rainfall areas.

Apply 3 to 4 gals. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre to control PERENNIAL WEEDS and GRASSES such as quackgrass, timothy, bluegrass, reedgrass, purpletop, orchardgrass, meadow fescue, aster, dandelion, dock, fern, yarrow, plantain, and wild carrot. In areas with low or no rainfall, rates as low as 4 gals. per acre control many perennial weeds and grasses.

Apply 12 to 14 gals. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre to control PERENNIAL WEEDS and GRASSES such as bermudagrass, dallisgrass, crabgrass, and others. Bo-Rid B-1 will not provide satisfactory control of hard-to-kill deep-rooted perennial weeds such as Johnsongrass.

Use the higher levels of the dosage ranges on absorptive soils (usually those high in organic matter or carbon).

Retreatment: Apply 1.5 to 6 gals. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre when annual weeds and grasses reappear on sites where weed growth has been controlled.

For Small Areas: 1/2 to 1 gal. Bo-Rid B-1 per acre is approximately 1/2 gal. per acre.
