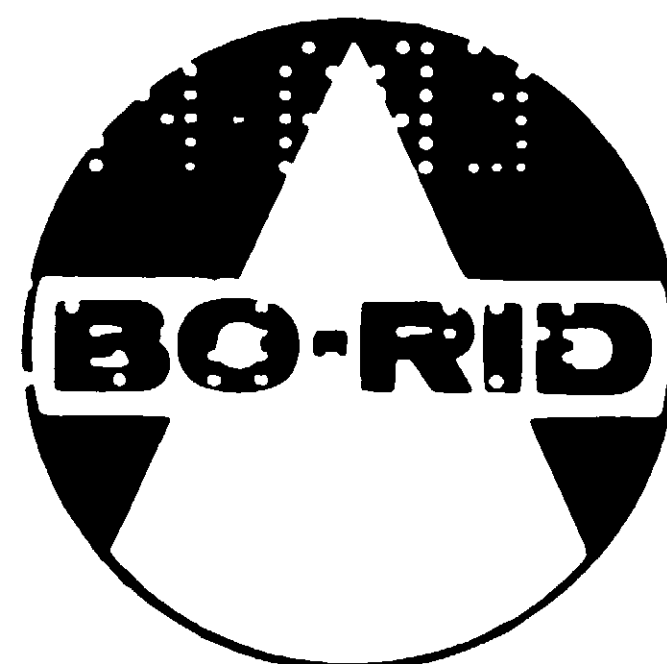

The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall and other conditions.

BO-RID 10FP Semi Soil Sterilant is formulated for use with mechanical, motor and hand operated spreading equipment. Effect of applications are usually slow to appear and may not become evident until the herbicide has been carried to the root zone by moisture. Because the effect of BO-RID 10FP Semi Soil Sterilant varies with environmental conditions, such as soil moisture, use, you should consult experimental stations, extension service, or specialists for suggestions on use in your soil conditions.

Thoroughly clean application equipment after use to prevent possible contamination of selective herbicides subsequently used. Do not wash or flush spreader near lawns, valuable trees or other adjacent areas into which the roots may extend.

BO-RID 10FP Semi-Soil Sterilant, when used at rates of 200 lbs. per acre, is an effective general treatment for the control of most annual and perennial grasses and weeds in non-cropland areas where bare ground is desired.

BO-RID 10FP Semi-Soil Sterilant may be used at any time of year on general vegetation control, provided the material is moved to the root zone.

Because the effectiveness of BO-RID 10FP Semi-Soil Sterilant varies with environmental conditions and species of vegetation, user should consult experiment station or extension service weed specialists for suggestions for use under local conditions.

BO-RID 10FP SEMI-SOIL STERILANT DIRECTIONS

Use a mechanical spreader or other device which will spread the required amount of BO-RID 10FP SEMI-SOIL STERILANT evenly over the area to be treated. BO-RID 10FP SEMI-SOIL STERILANT should be applied before growth starts to take advantage of early season moisture in the soil.

GENERAL VEGETATION CONTROL. To control most annual and perennial weeds for extended periods of time on non-cropland such as UTILITY, HIGHWAY, PIPELINE and RAILROAD RIGHTS OF WAY, PETROLEUM TANK FARMS, LUMBER YARDS, STORAGE AREAS, DRAINAGE DITCHBANKS, and INDUSTRIAL PLANT SITES, apply BO-RID 10FP SEMI-SOIL STERILANT at 200 pounds per acre. A repeat spot treatment may be required where a longer period of control is desired. Second year spot treatment is usually satisfactory following a first year thorough application.
