Brotab is intended for use on utility, highway, pipeline, railroad rights-of-way, and other industrial sites, drainage ditch banks, fencerows, and around farm buildings. Application as directed will result in loss of soil productivity for an extended period.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

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Method of Application: Best results are obtained if application is made after foliage has appeared in the spring, but before growth has progressed sufficiently to retain more than half of the spray. Earlier or later applications also are effective, but rates near the upper end of the recommended dosage range may be required. Applications should be made just before or after the plants begin to grow. Brotab can be applied by hand or by machine.
