FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Apply directly to the insects. Shut doors and windows, press valve and spray into all parts of room, especially the upper corners. Fill room with mist. Keep about 3 feet from walls, fabric and furniture. Also spray areas where pests may tend to congregate such as around windows, doors, and corners, and other areas. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Air freshener odor may persist for several days.

ANTS, ROACHES, FLEAS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES: Spray directly on insect, wherever it is seen and on areas where insects may be found such as under sinks, around drains, behind cracks and crevices of baseboards, pipes, and under floorboards. Also spray areas where pests may tend to congregate such as around windows, doors, and corners, and other areas. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Air freshener odor may persist for several days.

ANIMAL PESTS—DOGS, CATS: Fleas. Apply directly to animal on a back, under foreleg, and on other areas kept free of hair.

Also spray entire inside surface of non-traveler's carpet as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made immediately after insecticide is applied. Spray the nest thoroughly and seal it with caulk or putty. Repeat as necessary.

INDOORS — FOR PROTECTION OF WOOLENS: Apply only to garments, blankets, carpets, and other woolen fabrics while they are stored for protection from damage of washing, drying, moth and insect infestations.


Do not use on woolen fabrics until they are dry before treating. Clean carpet and upholstery with vacuum thoroughly before treating.

Hold nozzle about 12 to 18 inches from the material and apply the insecticide in a steady stream forward and back motion. Do not spray directly at the animal. One to two seconds per linear foot. For maximum protection, please treat carpets after vacuuming and mopping. Also treat cracks and crevices of insect entry points, such as where baseboards are being stored. Treat the cracks and crevices at the rate of two seconds per linear foot.

When applied as directed on wall and in storage areas this treatment will offer protection for 6 months. To insure protection, repeat application every three months. Avoid heavy applications. When possible, make application outdoors. If application is made indoors, do not re-occupy the treated area. Ventilate the area after treatment is complete.

OUNCES

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Apply indoors to control these insects. Shut doors and windows, press valve and direct spray to corners of room, especially the upper corners and other areas. Fill the room with mist. Keep about 2 feet from walls, fabric and furniture. Also spray areas where pests may tend to congregate such as around windows, doors, and cracks in woodwork and trim joints. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Wash before occupancy. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS, ROACHES, FLEAS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES: Spray directly on insects wherever they are and on areas where insects may be found such as under sinks, around and behind drains and crevices, on light switches, pipes, and under windows. Spray on floors and baseboards, in cracks, under the sofa and living room furniture, around doors, "door-sealing" and "weather-stripping" where pests may be found. Repeat as necessary.

ANIMAL PESTS—DOGS, CATS: Fleas. Apply directly to animal's back, under foreleg, and on other areas. Part hair to reach

foot skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not directly spray in eyes, ears, or mouth of animal. To reduce re-infestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting areas. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot while spraying at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray entire inside of animal's cages. Repeat as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray thoroughly on nesting and trailing places, contacting animals and their nests. Repeat as necessary.

INDOORS — FOR PROTECTION OF WOOLENS: Apply only to garments, blankets, coats, and other woollen fabric, and the floor in storage areas, such as the inside of wetting clothing racks and dark cupboards.


Do not use on woolens until they are dry before treating. Clean carpet, drapes, and other floor coverings thoroughly, brushing before treating.

Hold the nozzle 14 to 16 to 20 inches from the fabric and spray the spray which is directed evenly in a forward and downward motion on the fabric, with a duration of one to two seconds. Spray the entire fabric until it is slightly moist or damp to the touch. When possible, treat wet sides of the fabric. Do not spray on wet fabric. For maximum protection place treated fabrics after drying in a plastic paper bag. Also treat cracks and crevices of closets, chests, and trunks where there fabric is being stored. Treat the cracks and crevices at the rate of two seconds per linear foot.

When applied as directed on fabric in storage areas this treatment will offer protection for 6 months. To insure protection inspect the fabric in the storage area once every three months. Repeat application when necessary. Avoid heavy applications. When possible make application outdoors. If application is made indoors, do not remain in treated area until the area dries after treatment is complete.
