

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read entire label. Use in strict accordance with label directions and precautions.

GENERAL: Apply Sevin 5% Dust whenever insect damage appears. Best results are obtained when applied in early morning or late evening hours. Thoroughly dust upper and lower surfaces of foliage. Avoid excessive applications. Except as noted, repeat applications at 7 day intervals as needed to maintain control.

Asparagus—Asparagus Beetle and Apache Cicada. Apply during cutting season. DO NOT repeat application within 3 days. DO NOT apply within one day of harvest.

Beans—Bean Beetles, Leafhoppers, Armyworms, Stink Bugs.

Corn—Corn Earworm, European Corn Borer, Japanese Beetles, Leafhoppers, Sap Beetles and Flea Beetles. For insects attacking silk and ears, start when first silks appear and every 2 to 3 days until silks begin to dry. Three or more applications are often necessary.

Cucumbers, Melons, Pumpkins—Squashworms, Cucumber Beetles, Leafhoppers and Squashbugs. Avoid excessive applications. Some leaf injury may occur if tender foliage is wet or during periods prolonged high humidity. DO NOT use on Watermelons.

Potatoes, Tomatoes, Eggplant, Peppers—Colorado Potato Leafhopper, Fall Armyworms, Lace Bug Worms, Stink Bugs.

Head Lettuce—Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bugs, Leafhoppers, Armyworms, Stink Bugs. For Cabbage Peppers apply at 5-7 day intervals. DO NOT apply within three days of harvest.

Grapes—Grape Berry Moth, Japanese Beetle, Leaf Miner, Leaf Folder, and Grape Leaf Skeletonizer. Apply just before first brood Leaf Folder larvae emerge from rolls and as needed for Leafhoppers.

Strawberries—Spittlebug, Leaf Roller and Strawberry Weevil. DO NOT apply within one day of harvest.

Blueberries—Blueberry Maggot, Cherry and Strawberry Fruitworm. Do not apply more than 1/2 lb per 25 sq ft.

Ornamentals—Japanese Beetle, Leafhopper, Exposed Thrip, Bagworm, Elm Leaf Beetle. Apply dust as early as possible. Avoid excessive applications. Do not use on Boston Ivy or Virginia Creeper.

Grasshoppers—Apply Sevin 5% Dust on the above crops as needed to control infestation.

IMPORTANT: Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated soil must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl labels.

Dogs and Cats, Ticks and Fleas—Apply dust liberally to the pet's fur. Avoid eyes and rub thoroughly into skin. Wash out dead fleas a few hours after treatment. Repeat weekly as needed. DO NOT treat puppies and kittens less than 4 weeks of age. Do not use on pregnant dogs. Dust liberally around all kennel, animal, kennels and dog houses. It is not recommended for use in carpeted areas as staining may occur.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 to 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Never induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **If on skin:** Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected areas with soap and water. **If in eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of clean water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible, cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is an antidote.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse canister. Discard canister in trash.




