TOMATOES — For control of aphids, flea beetles, leafhoppers, leaf miners, and mites, se as follows. In planting seed use 1 ½ cups per 50 ft. of row in furrow with seed.

In transplanting put 2 level teaspoonfuls per plant in the transplant hole and mix with soil before setting plant.


