DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling. This product may not be used against any pest not named on the label.
 This product may be applied under the direct supervision of a certified applicator who is not physically present at the site of application, but is nonetheless available to the person applying the pesticide.
 For use on lands not presently used or to be used for food or feed products, or for grazing, for a period of two years following treatment.
 For control of Imported Fire Ants make mound applications only. Broadcast applications are prohibited.
 Prepare a 0.5% emulsion in water according to the dilution guide below. Add the required amount of CHLORDANE 73% SPRAY to sufficient water to bring the emulsion up to the desired volume.
 Thoroughly saturate mounds using as much as 1 gallon of 0.5% emulsion per mound colony.

DILUTION GUIDE FOR CHLORDANE 73% SPRAY

Volume of 0.5% Emulsion Desired	Amount of Chlordane 73% Spray to Add
5 gallons	4 ounces
10 gallons	7 ounces
50 gallons	1 quart
100 gallons	2 quarts

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions — Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
Pesticide Disposal — Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used chemically processed should be disposed of in a land approved for pesticides buried in a safe place away from water supplies.
