

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer is a non-selective herbicide with a fast acting double killing action. It kills by contact and b root absorption. It is recommended for killing existing weed and grasses, and to prevent regrowth on walks, patios, driveways, blacktop and graveled areas, and playgrounds, and for creating firebreaks around structures in potential fire areas. The following are a few common weeds and other vegetation that can be destroyed and regrowth prevented with Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer: Oxalis, Crabgrass, Bermuda Grass, Rye, Oats, Barley, Foxtail, Dog Fennel, Plantain, Spotted Spurge, Pigweed, Puncture Vine, Mustard, Watergrass, Green Ground Mold, Malva, Wild Turnip, Lambsquarters, and such hard to kill perennial weeds as Hoary Cress, Dandelion, Wild Morning Glory, Johnson Grass, Bindweed and Wild Carrot. Also wood plants such as Poison Oak, Honeysuckle and Blackberry.

How to Apply: Uniformly spray 1/2 gal. of Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer in 2 gallons of water over 175-200 sq. ft. of soil surface. thoroughly wet all foliage to insure contact action. Best results are obtained when applications are made during or after weed emergence while growth is succulent. Where vegetation is tall and dense, use 3 quarts of Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer in 2 gallons of water per 100 sq. ft. For control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnson Grass, Bindweed, and Wild Carrot, use 1/2 gal. per 40 sq. ft. Although Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer has considerable activity through foliar contact, much of its activity is through the roots and, therefore, adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone is necessary. Under conditions where the rainfall is high and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary to maintain a weed-free soil surface. Two days after applying Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer, water the treated area deeply to increase plant absorption. One day treatment normally provides control for a full season. Repeat application if necessary.

Spot Treatment: For woody plants such as poison oak, honeysuckle, blackberry and Bermuda grass on driveways, patios, and parking lots apply at the rate of 1/2 gallon Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer mixed with 4 gallons of water over 100 sq. ft. Spray all exposed parts and saturate the soil around the base. Follow with deep watering. Use a tank sprayer or sprinkling can. Consult the following table to determine the amounts of Dexol Barren Concentrate Vegetation Killer and water required for other area rates:
