Alydids, Mimosa Webworm, Redhumped Caterpillar, Thistle exposed. Use 12 fl. oz. in 9 gals. water. For control of Ash and Lilac Borers, Oak Pine Needle, Tea and White Peach Scale Crawlers. Use 12 fl. oz. in 12 gals. water. **NOTE:** 1 fl. oz. = 2 tbsp = 6 tsp
