



**Subject: Notification of Labeling Amendment of Environmental Hazard Statement for Dexol Vegetable Insect Killer, EPA Reg. No. 192-144.**

The purpose of this label amendment is to amend the Environmental Hazard section of the product labeling in order to comply with PR Notice 93-3.

### Environmental Hazard Statement

The Environmental Hazard Statement on the most recent approved labeling, stamped approved by EPA on 1-30-90, states:

“This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.”

This labeling amendment simply updates the Environmental Hazard to agree with PR Notices 93-3. The amended Environmental Hazard Statement is:

“This product is toxic to fish. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.”

I have included five (5) copies of the revised labeling as well as a completed Application for Pesticide Amendment. Also included is a copy of the latest EPA Stamped Approved labeling dated 1-30-1990, and a copy of PR Notice 93-3.
