1. Revise the pest "Ticks" to "Brown Dog Ticks" in "Lawns" and "Outside Nuisance Pests" sections, since this is the tick species registered by the Agency and the only species registered in California.
2. We believe you mean "imported fire ants" rather than "red fire ants" since imported fire ants is the pest claimed by your supplier for diazinon products.
