

## DEXOL DEXA-KLOR PEST CONTROL

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DEXOL DEXA-KLOR PEST CONTROL** is a water based, ready to use insecticide for control of fleas and brown dog ticks indoors and outdoors. Use for spot treatment on floor coverings, walls, pet beds, etc. indoors as well as outdoors on non crop bushes, lawns and soil areas. Will not stain and leaves no oily residue.

Easy to use. No mixing or measuring. Spray surfaces thoroughly and repeat as needed. (Spot test for color fastness before spraying.)

### DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.

**INDOORS:** Thoroughly apply as a very fine mist spray as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. To control the source of flea infestation on pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for application to animals. Repeat treatment in 7-10 days to kill newly hatched fleas which may have hatched from eggs left in the carpet and other areas. Repeat as necessary. Keep children and pets out of sprayed areas until spray has dried (approximately fifteen to thirty minutes). Remove pets and cover fish tanks before spraying. Do not allow spray to contact feed, feedstuffs and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by this product.

**OUTDOORS:** Thoroughly spray localized infestations of fleas and ticks in weeds, bushy non crop areas, shrubs, lawns and other areas or where you use these pest control products. Thoroughly wet ant hills and runways. Repeat applications as reinfestations occur.

Fleas are a common problem in homes with pets such as dogs and cats. They bite and cause blood-letting and they're still a pest problem that can last for months after pets are out of the house without proper spraying treatment.

The adult flea is a tiny wingless insect with a flat body. Its legs are flattened with long backward-pointing spines which enable it to leap easily through the hairs of pets. Treatment for complete elimination of the flea can be obtained by spraying with this product. The female lays eggs among the hairs of the animals. These eggs hatch and the larvae that feed on carpeting and other animal hair and skin are the pest problem. Fleas and ticks are a year-round problem. Full flea and tick infestation usually begins in the spring.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by forcing back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If on Skin: In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water. If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do Not Use or Store Near Heat or Open Flame. Do Not Store Below 32°F.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams and ponds. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on plants. For more information, be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
