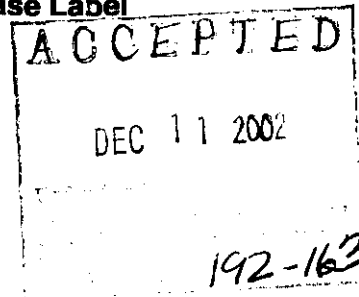

FIRST AID
