Add directions for use on "trees" and "vines" or delete "trees" and "vines" from the label.

Delete "etc." and "and others" from the list of plants on which this product may be used.

Revise the first sentence of the precautionary statements to read as follows: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin.

Add to the If Swallowed First Aid Statements the following: Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.

Move the emergency telephone number so that it immediately follows the First Aid Statements.

Revise the Pesticide Disposal and Container Disposal statements as follows: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
