This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) or FIFRA sec. 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. On the front panel, add the word Only after the statement: For Use in and around the home only.

b. In the directions for use on roaches, etc., after "...sinks, stoves, and similar areas where these insects hide." add the following:

Do not spray inside cabinets where food is stored. Discard infested food packages. Do not spray across top of stove or near pilot lights.

c. Correct the spelling of earwits to earwigs.

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- d. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statements incorporating the highlighted text to read as follows:

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin of susceptible individuals. Avoid repeated contact with skin. If sensitization reactions result, consult a physician. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets from areas, and cover fish bowl before spraying. Keep children and pests off treated areas until areas are dry.

- e. Add the following IF SWALLOWED statement to the Statement of Practical Treatment:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING UNLESS NO OTHER TREATMENT IS AVAILABLE. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing.

- f. Since the product is limited to use in/around homes, delete the statement beginning, "Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments.... Do not use in serving areas..."

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

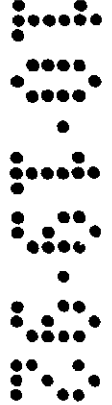

(BACK PANEL - DEXOL ANT, ROACH & SPIDER CONTROL)

General Information: This product is a ready-to-use microemulsion containing diazinon. There is no need for further dilution. This product is intended for use inside the home and for limited use outside the home as a spot treatment to use foundation walls and around windows and doors for the control of those pests specified on this label. NOTE: Do not use this product indoors as an overall surface spray or as a space spray; take care not to introduce this product into the air during application. Use only in well-ventilated areas. Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces. Remove or cover fish bowls and remove pets before application. Do not treat pets or plants with this product. Do not allow children or pets in treated areas until spray is dried. If clothing is sprayed during application, remove clothing immediately after spraying and launder before wearing again. Avoid excessive wetting of carpets or floor coverings and unfinished materials. Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, wall coverings, and fabrics. Do not apply directly to upholstery, furniture, leather, draperies, or stained surfaces because damage may occur. Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will contact food or feed. Exposed food should be covered or removed during application. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application or washed with soap and water before use. Do not use this product in conduits, motor housing, or electrical switch boxes. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INDOOR USE

Cockroaches (Waterbugs), Ants, Silverfish: Make spot applications to baseboards, areas around water pipes, cracks and crevices, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and similar areas where these insects hide. Spray areas until wet. Repeat application as necessary to maintain control. Carpet Beetles: Spray in spot applications along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelving, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Spiders and Scorpions: Spray around windows, doors, and along baseboards. Make spot applications to other areas over which these pests may crawl. Brown dog ticks, Fleas*: Apply to infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets, and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. ~~Kennel~~ bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this product. Repeat as necessary. *Controls adult fleas on areas treated.

PANTRY PESTS-Exposed Stages(Sawtoothed grain beetle, flour beetle, rice weevil, cigarette beetle, drugstore beetle, Indian meal moth): Spray on shelves and in cupboards where food containers suspected of being infested are stored. Remove all food and shelving paper before spraying. Do not replace the food packages until spray has dried. Cover shelves with shelving paper. This treatment is supplemental to good housekeeping, since it will have no effect on insects breeding within food packages. Infested food packages should be destroyed.

OUTDOOR USE

This product will control: Ants, boxelder bugs, brown dog ticks, chiggers, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, earwits, fleas, flies, millipedes, sowbugs, spiders, and collembola(springtails) which are commonly found near the house and may enter the house. NOTE: Spray with wind to your back. If clothing becomes wet from spray during use, remove clothing after spraying, wash affected body areas thoroughly with soap and water, and launder clothing before wearing again. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Do not apply to lawns or other desirable plants. Directions: Apply as a spot treatment to house foundation walls and around doors and windows where these pests are likely to enter. Repeat application as necessary.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Keep from freezing. Store above 32°F. Store in an area inaccessible to children and pets. Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

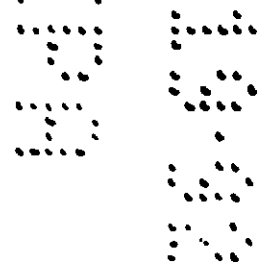

Statement of Practical Treatment

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Note to Physician: Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.



Environmental Hazards

This product is highly toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estaries. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues on blooming plants where they feed. Do not allow this pesticide to drift to blooming weeds, if bees are visiting the treatment area. Do not apply this product to or allow it to drift to food crops or any desirable vegetation at any time.
